

BELLEVUE PARK COMMUNITY POOL RULES

The pool is for the private use of the residents of Westminster Estates, Edmonton Commons, Paddington Square, and Stratford Paddington – known as the Community of Bellevue Park. Absentee owners/landlords, or residents not current with their HOA dues are not permitted to use the pool. There is a limit of two guests per resident, maximum of 4 guests per visit. All guests must be accompanied by a resident at all times. The pool gate must be locked and closed at all times. Each resident can apply for 1 pool fob, for free – additional pool fobs will cost \$25. Pool hours are 10AM-9PM, the board may change or restrict hours as needed for maintenance.

1. POOL IS ONLY FOR THE USE OF RESIDENTS AND THEIR GUESTS
2. GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESIDENT AT ALL TIMES
3. NO PERSON IS PERMITTED TO SWIM ALONE
4. CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 14 AND/OR WITHOUT SWIMMING SKILLS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT
5. CHILDREN MAY USED APPROVED FLOTATION DEVICES
6. PROPER SWIMWEAR IS REQUIRED. ONLY SWIM DIAPERS PERMITTED IN POOL.
7. NO DIVING, FLIPS, RUNNING OR ROUGH PLAY IN THE POOL AREA. VIOLATORS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE POOL AREA.
8. PERSONS WITH OPEN SORES OR COMMUNICABLE DISEASES ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE POOL.
9. THE FOLLOWING ARE PROHIBITED IN THE POOL AREA:
 - SMOKING, ALCOHOL, GLASS,
 - PETS, CHEWING GUM
 - RUNNING, DIVING OR DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR, AND TOYS OF ANY TYPE
 - EXCESSIVE NOISE, SPLASHING, AND MUSIC WITHOUT HEADPHONES
 - PRIVATE POOL PARTIES, ELECTRICAL DEVICES
10. LOUNGE CHAIRS AND TABLES MAY NOT BE RESERVED
11. PLEASE PROTECT FURNITURE WITH A TOWEL WHEN USING SUN-TANNING LOTION
12. PLEASE KEEP AREA CLEAN. RETURN ALL FURNITURE AND EQUIPMENT TO ITS ORIGINAL LOCATION AFTER USE.
13. TRASH MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE POOL AREA, PUBLIC TRASH RECEPTACLES WILL NOT BE PROVIDED.
14. THE BOARD MAY CLOSE THE POOL OR DELAY OPENING AT ANY TIME DUE TO CONDITIONS THAT MAY IMPACT THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE RESIDENTS
15. THE BOARD MAY EJECT ANY PERSON FROM THE POOL AND UNSAFE OR OBJECTIONABLE BEHAVIOR. OR REGULAR OR EXTREME VIOATION OF THESE RULES. THE BOARD MAY REVOKE OR SUSPEND POOL PRIVILEGES FOR THE RESIDENT AND THEIR FAMILY.
16. ALL POOL RULES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE
17. ALL SWIMMING AND POOL ACTIIVITES ARE AT THE RISK OF THE RESIDENT AND THEIR GUESTS. THERE WILL BE NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY.
